12 Step Workshop, Agenda 1 Body, Mind & Spirit

Note: this is for reference only. I'm just suggesting that by looking for references to <u>The Body</u> (beginning to pg 23), <u>The Mind</u> (pg 23-44) and <u>The Spirit</u> (pag 44-63), and then writing them down, or highlighting them in your Big Book will therefore give you a clearer understanding of what this exercise is all about. I find that by looking for the references to each and physically writing them down, it makes my experience much more intense & interesting. These are my notes. It's best if you do your own work and create your own notes because different words/passages will catch YOUR attention, differently from mine. (PS spiritual matters are mentioned throughout all these pages, but I just focused on first, the body only, second, the mind only, and third, the spirit only),

The Body

- XXVI the body of the alcoholic is quite as abnormal as his mind <u>Doctor's theory that we have an allergy</u>
